



The new Shellharbour Marina by Isabel Wartho



Built by the local Council in partnership with a property developer. Houses built all around, for sale now. Onsite Woolworths, cafes, restaurants, netted kids beach, large decks, terraces.

NB Don't confuse Shellharbour with Shell Cove.

I spoke to Ben Schooley, General Manager.

The marina is not yet on Navionics, but they do have a hydrographic survey. Most of the berths are 3.1m deep, it's 3.5m in centre section and the outermost D arm is 4.2m-4.4m. Deeper keeled boats can wait at the entrance for high tide.

A new marina office, shower block & laundry facilities will be built this year. As will the second area of berths.

Costs: \$63/day, \$312/week. A permanent berth is \$936/month payable by the month with no lock-in.

RPA did a 10 boat cruise here recently. CYC, the Amateurs and MYC have also visited to investigate.
